CONFIRMATION AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Registered participants are responsible for arranging their travel from the place of their residence to Warsaw in Poland at the given dates (see below). CIM Horyzonty as host organization will arrange group transfer for all the participants from Warsaw to the venue and back to Warsaw.

****Please do not make travel arrangements until the program has been confirmed****

You will be notified when the program has been confirmed. We aim to confirm programs no later than 30 days prior to the start date. CIM Horyzonty is not responsible for the costs of travel arrangements made before the program has been confirmed. The program is confirmed once the minimum number of participants is reached.

HEALTH AND SPECIAL NEEDS FORM

After the project is confirmed and when you are ready with your travel arrangements, please fill in the Travel, [Health and Special needs Form](#), which provides us with the necessary data for organizing your participation in the program.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Dates of the program: **July 22 – 26, 2026**

Start time: July 22 at 1 PM

End time: July 26, 1 PM

***Please note:** the journey from Warsaw to the venue (Gajrowskie) will take about 4 hours by bus, so the bus needs to depart at 7:00 in order to arrive to the venue before the program starts. CIM Horyzonty will organize **a bus transfer** from Warsaw to Gajrowskie on the **22nd of July** in the morning and back to Warsaw on the **26th of July** after the closing of the program. The cost of the transfer is included in the program fee.*

*You should arrive to Warsaw on the **21st of July** and depart on the **27th of July** 2026 to ensure you don't miss the arranged bus transfer, because there is no public transportation to the venue available.*

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

The program is open for everyone who is over 18 years old and motivated to personal development or interested in exploring further programs of Animas Valley Institute.

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

Minimum number for confirming the program – 12 ppl

Maximum number of participants – 24 ppl

PRICE AND PAYMENT

The maximum price of the program is **950 EUR**.

Upon registration, you will be asked to pay a **deposit of 300 EUR** to secure your place.

At the moment of confirmation of the program, the price of the program will be calculated again and you will be asked to pay a maximum of **400 EUR** by bank transfer.

The **remaining 250 EUR** you will pay in cash upon arrival to the venue, and it covers food and accommodation.

***Note:** The maximum price of the program is 950 EUR. The price will vary depending on the number of participants. After you have paid the deposit and the program is confirmed, the final price will be calculated and you will be asked to pay the second instalment. The final instalment will remain unchanged as it covers the food and accommodation.*

THE PRICE OF THE PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Accommodation and food (3 meals per day);
- Program fee;
- Organized bus transfer from Warsaw to the venue and back to Warsaw.

There will be limited financial aid available for this program for those who are unable to pay the full fee. Please contact edukacja@cimhoryzonty.org to express interest for a scholarship and learn more about how to apply.

PERSONAL HEALTH

INSURANCE: Due to the complexity of the program, each participant needs to have a comprehensive travel and medical insurance, covering both the travel and the stay from the first until the last day of the way back home.

HEALTH FORM: It is very important that you notify us of any health risk or possibly necessary medicines. After you register for the program, you will be invited to fill in an online [Travel, health and special needs form](#). The information you've provided on any special needs does not remove your own personal responsibility for ensuring your own health.

WHAT TO BRING

The weather in July in Poland can be unpredictable: from very hot to sometimes cold and rainy. Have in mind that many of the program activities will be outdoors. For this reason, please carefully prepare yourself.

We recommend that you bring:

- Clothes and shoes suitable for walking/hiking;
- Warm and waterproof clothes – as said before, the weather in Poland is unpredictable and evenings can be quite chilly.
- Towel(s), soap and shampoo;
- Warm woolly socks or/and slippers for walking inside the facilities;
- Your own medication (if required);
- A flashlight or headlamp – for evenings outside;
- A small backpack for wanders in nature;
- Drums, rattles, and other small percussion instruments;
- **REQUIRED:** emergency whistle (the loud one that can be found in camping stores)

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

REGISTRATION POLICY

Your registration is complete, and your space in the program is secured when:

1. You have completed and submitted the [application form](#) (including agreement with our policies)
2. You have paid the deposit of **300 EUR**
3. You have received an email stating that your registration and payment have been successfully processed.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation by the host organization (CIM Horyzonty): If a minimum number of participants are not registered 30 days prior to the program start date, the program may be cancelled. If CIM Horyzonty cancels the program due to not having the minimum number of participants or other unforeseen circumstances, registered participants will receive a full refund.

Cancellation by You: To apply to this program is to say “yes” to potentially life-changing journey. It’s not unusual for fear, resistance, or an apparent scheduling conflict to surface as the time of your program nears. We believe that whatever arises is a part of your journey and is ripe with opportunity and meaning. The following cancellation policy is designed to support you in honoring your commitment and to support our staff and guides as they prepare for your program:

1. **Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferrable.** If you cancel a program for any reason, your deposit is forfeited and will be considered a donation to CIM Horyzonty. In case of cancellation due to FORCE MAJEURE, after mutual agreement candidate may receive a refund of the deposit.
2. **Payment of the second installment (400 EUR) will be refunded,** with the exception below:
 - ✧ If notice of cancellation is received by the host organization **30 days or less** before the start of the program, the payment is not refundable.
3. **These terms stand even if there is a waitlist** for the program and we are able to fill your spot.

PAYMENT POLICY

Deposit: Payment of the non-refundable deposit reserves your place in the program – registration is not complete, and your space is not guaranteed until the full deposit of **300 EUR** has been received by CIM Horyzonty.

Second Instalment: after closing the application process and confirming at least the minimum number of participants in the program, the final cost of the program will be calculated, and you will be asked to pay the second instalment in the amount of a maximum of **400 EUR** by bank transfer.

Final instalment: the remaining **250 EUR** will be paid in cash upon your arrival at the venue.

When registering less than 30 days prior to the start of a program, payment of the deposit and the second installment is required (700 EUR). This payment is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

OTHER

Sharing Personal Information: It is a standard procedure to share your full name, email address and phone number with other participants of this program along with the program guides. This is so you may contact one another before or after completing the program (i.e. carpooling purposes, email council, etc). By agreeing to our policies and procedures, you consent to the sharing of this information with other participants and guides.

No mind-altering substances policy: this program is mind-altering substances free (including the legal ones). We respectfully request that you do not bring and use of mind-altering plants, chemicals, and alcohol during the event.

CIM Horyzonty reserves the right to reject the application of anyone for any reason. CIM Horyzonty also reserves the right to screen participants for compatibility with this program. For the safety of all participants, we require you (and other participants) to be in good physical, mental and emotional health. This program can be physically and psychologically challenging.
